All students who attend Oklahoma schools are required to have the following immunizations*:



Pre-K

- 4 DTP/DTaP/Td
- 3 Polio
- 1 MMR
- 2 Hepatitis A
- 3 Hepatitis B
- 1 Varicella (Chicken Pox)

GRADES K-12

- 5 DTP/DTaP/Td (Unless the 4th dose was given on or after the 4th birthday)
- 4 Polio (Unless the 3rd dose was given on or after the 4th birthday)
- 2 MMR
- 2 Hepatitis A
- 3 Hepatitis B
- 1 Varicella (Chicken Pox)

GRADES 7-12

- 1 Tdap

Shots that are NOT required but are recommended for students ages 11** up:

- Meningococcal vaccine (MCV4)
- Human papillomavirus (HPV)- For females and males.
- Varicella (Chicken Pox) ** - a second dose at age 4
- Flu

*Oklahoma State law allows immunization exemptions for medical, religious or personal reasons.

Parents who opt not to immunize their children may obtain and complete an Immunization Exemption certificate [HERE](#). The DC Enrollment Center will process the completed application and send it to the Oklahoma State Department of Health. A school nurse will notify parents when the State Health Department returns the Exemption certificate to the child's school.
