IMMUNIZATIONS

All students who attend Oklahoma schools are required to have the following immunizations*:



Pre-K

- 4 DTP/DTaP/Td
- 3 Polio
- 1 MMR
- 2 Hepatitis A
- 3 Hepatitis B
- 1 Varicella (Chicken Pox)

GRADES K-12

- 5 DTP/DTaP/Td (Unless the 4th dose was given on or after the 4th birthday)
- 4 Polio (Unless the 3rd dose was given on or after the 4th birthday)
- 2 MMR
- 2 Hepatitis A
- 3 Hepatitis B
- 1 Varicella (Chicken Pox)

GRADES 7-12

1 Tdap

Shots that are NOT required but are recommended for students ages 11** up:

- Meningococcal vaccine (MCV4)
- Human papillomavirus (HPV)- For females and males.
- Varicella (Chicken Pox) ** a second dose at age 4
- Flu

*Oklahoma State law allows immunization exemptions for medical, religious or personal reasons.

Parents who opt not to immunize their children may obtain and complete an Immunization Exemption certificate HERE. The DC Enrollment Center will process the completed application and send it to the Oklahoma State Department of Health. A school nurse will notify parents when the State Health Department returns the Exemption certificate to the child's school.
